INTEREST STARTS IN THE UNITED STATES

The story of Mother's Day in US began with the efforts of a dynamic author and poetess, Julia Ward Howe in 1872. An activist to the very last, she utilized her potentials to further the cause of Mother's Day. She wrote a powerful Mother's Day Proclamation in Boston in 1870 and demanded declaration of official holiday and celebrations on Mother's Day. Her idea gained popularity but she could not get the idea implemented. Julia is also credited for penning words for Civil War song, "Battle Hymn of the Republic".

MEANING OF FLOWERS FOR MOTHER'S DAY

A loving daughter from West Virginia, Anna Jarvis is recognized as a 'founder of Mother's Day' and 'Mother of Mother's Day'. Anna kept the word of her activist mother, Mrs. Ann Marie Reeves Jarvis who once expressed a wish that someone should strive to provide mothers their due recognition after her mother's death in 1865. Anna's determination became strong and she along with several supporters started lobbying for the official holiday on Mother's Day by writing letters to the people in power.

To celebrate Mother's Day, Anna began to send her mothers favorite flowers, carnations in her local church requesting people to wear them in honor of their mothers. The idea gained immense popularity over the years and in 1910, West Virginia became the first state to recognize Mother's Day holiday. On May 8, 1914 President Woodrow Wilson signed a joint Resolution designating the second Sunday in May as Mother's Day.

ENGLAND'S MOTHERING SUNDAY

During the 1500's, England celebrated a day called "Mothering Sunday", celebrated on the 4th Sunday of Lent (also called Mid-Lent Sunday). "Mothering Sunday" honored the mothers of England. As Christianity spread throughout Europe the celebration changed to honor the "Mother Church" - the spiritual power that gave them life and protected them from harm. Over time the church festival blended with the Mothering Sunday celebration. People began honoring their mothers as well as the church. During this time many of the England's poor worked as servants for the wealthy. As most jobs were located far from their homes, the servants would live at the houses of their employers. On Mothering Sunday the servants would have the day off and were encouraged to return home and spend the day with their mothers.

A special cake, called the mothering cake, was often brought along to provide a motherly touch. Sometimes farmery was served - wheat grains boiled in sweet milk, sugared and spiced. In northern England and in Scotland, the preferred refreshments were carlings - pancakes made of steeped peas fried in butter, with pepper and salt. In fact, in some locations this day was called Carling Sunday.

Another kind of mothering cake was the simnel cake, a very rich fruit cake. The Lenten fast dictated that the simnel cake had to keep until Easter. It was baked in water, then baked, and was often flavored with an almond glaze. Sometimes the crust was flour and water, colored with saffron.

MOTHER'S DAY STORY

The story of Mother's Day is a long one. It is neither a recent phenomenon as many people believe it to be. Nor is it the creation of card and gift marketers syndicate as assumed by cynics of Mother's Day festival. In the surprise of lot many people, Mother's Day celebrations are first said to have taken place in the time of ancient Greeks and Romans hundreds of years ago. Even Mother's Day celebrations in US began much before the tradition saw the light of the day in US. In US the efforts of Mrs. Julia Ward Howe and Mrs. Anna Jarvis are greatly recognized for starting the tradition of Mother's Day but several other women too made remarkable contribution to further the cause of Mother's Day holiday.

Today Mother's Day is celebrated in more than 46 countries around the world though at different times in the month of May and in some countries it is celebrated in entirely different times of the year. In the present times Mother's Day has come to be internationally recognized as the day to honor all mothers and thank them for the services they impart for the benefit of their individual child and consequently to the development of mankind. EARLY CELEBRATIONS

The earliest Mother's Day celebrations are traced back to the spring celebrations of ancient Greece in honor of Rhea, wife of Cronus and the Mother of the Gods and goddesses. In Rome the most significant Mother's Day like festival was dedicated to the worship of Cybele, another mother goddess. Ceremonies in her honor began some 250 years before Christ was born. The Roman religious celebration, known as Hilaria, lasted for three days - from March 15 to 18! Some say the ceremonies in honor of Cybele were adopted by the early church to venerate the Mother of Christ, Mary. Others believe the Mother Church was substituted for mother goddess and custom began to dictate that a person visit the church of his/her baptism on this day. People attended the mother church of their parish, fasten with offerings.
